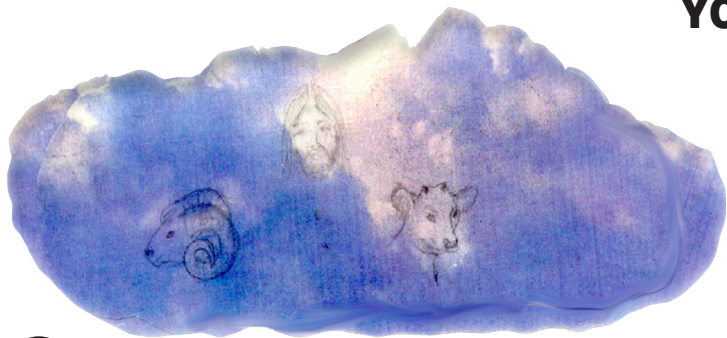
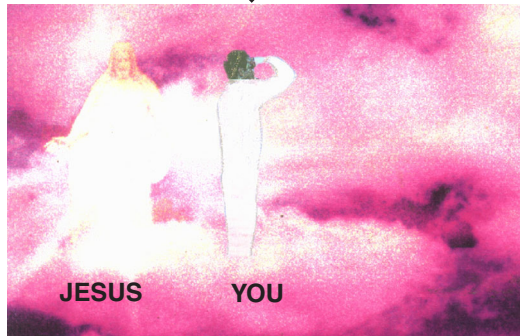
Did God create man in his own image?

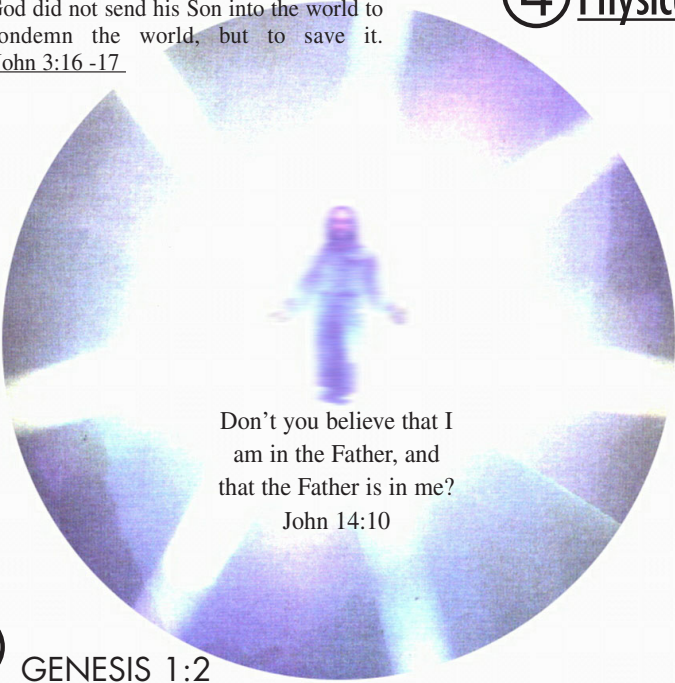

⁵ Jesus replied, "What I am telling you so earnestly is this: Unless one is born of water* and the Spirit, he cannot enter the Kingdom of God.

⁶ Men can only reproduce human life, but the Holy Spirit gives new life from heaven. ⁷ So don't be surprised at my statements that you must be born again! ⁸ Just as you can hear the wind but can't tell where it comes from or where it will go next, so it is with the Spirit. We do not know whom he will next bestow this life from heaven."

To receive Jesus, pray

*Thank you Lord, for loving me!
"Lord Jesus, I'm a sinner. Please
come into my life and forgive me of*

all sin. I believe You died for my sins and rose from the dead. Now, fill me with Your Holy Spirit and guide me from this day.

⑦ What do I have to do to be saved? (John 3:3)

To be saved you must turn away from sin, believe in death and resurrection of Jesus and receive Him as Lord and Savior of your life.

Here is the step-by-step process. First, you must consider your life and then turn away from everything in it that is contrary to what God wants. This turning away from selfishness and toward God is called repentance (Matt. 3:7-10, Acts 3:19)

Second, you must acknowledge that Jesus Christ died on the Cross to forgive you of sin. You take Him as your Savior to cleanse you from sin- as the substitute who paid the price due for your sin (Rom. 5:9,10, Titus 2:14)

Third, you must ask Him to be Lord of your life, acknowledging openly and verbally that Jesus is not only your Savior but also your Lord (1 John 2:23).

The Bible says that as many as received Him were given the power to become the sons of God (John 1:23). So when you open your heart and receive Him, He comes into your heart- your inner person- through His Holy Spirit, and begins to live His life in you. From that point it is your privilege and call to confess what God has done (Rom. 10:9).
